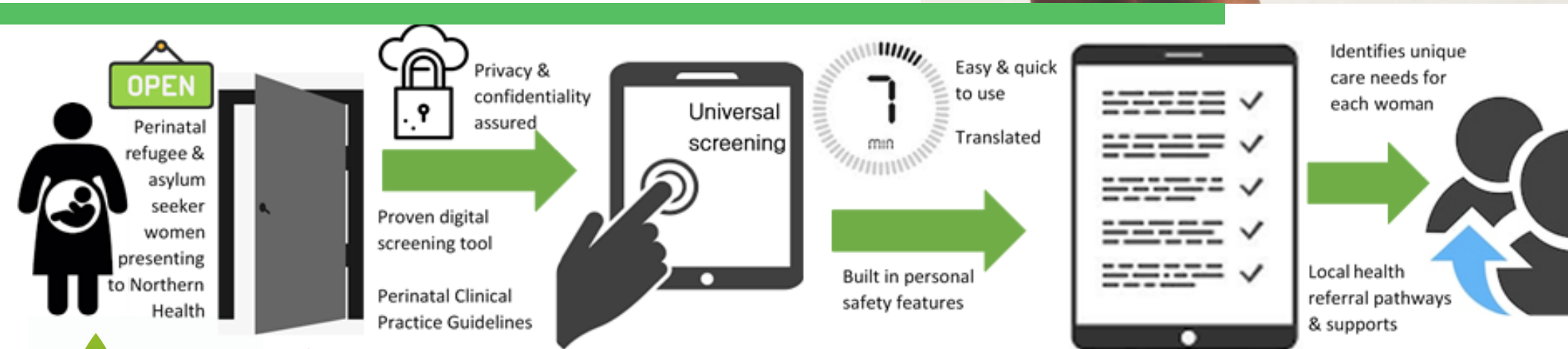
There are significant benefits to the community if this successful partnership initiative and integrated tool is replicated across multiple perinatal health care settings in the North.
