Victorian Government Emergency Relief Packages	 The program is to support people in mandatory self-isolation, who have little or no food, and no network of family and friends to sup Each eligible household will receive a two-week supply of essential goods. Food packages will include items such as long-life milk, pasta, cereal, canned vegetables and sugar. Personal care packages will also be distributed to eligible households and include soap, toothpaste and deodorant. Additional items is the needs of the household, such as nappies or baby formula. The packages will be delivered door-to-door. The emergency relief program is for those in mandatory self-isolation only. To qualify for support you must answer yes to one of the Have you been diagnosed with the Coronavirus? Have you been in contact with someone with Coronavirus in the past 14 days? Have you been advised by a health professional that you must self-isolate (for example has your GP or medical clinic advised Packages can be accessed by calling Victoria's Coronavirus hot-line on 1800 675 398. Those contacting the hotline may have to their relevant local government. The hotline can also refer people to other support services if needed.
