The VicPCPs Leadership Executive has governance responsibility for VicPCPs activity, however Individual Primary Care Partnerships have their own governance processes and structure.

Purpose - VicPCPs exists to support and promote the Primary Care Partnership platform and the broader use of partnerships to achieve improvements in population health and wellbeing.

Individual Primary Care Partnerships - Executive Governance Group

Area Accountability: PCP Catchment (1 – 5 LGAs) – PCP staff employed on behalf of the partnership by nominated lead agency/auspice; Executive Officer (EO) responsible for staff on behalf of the employer and accountable to PCP governance group.


Formal Reporting: Governance group with the guidance of EO reports to DHHS Central Office and Divisional office as per FASA.

Membership: Generally 2 tiers of PCP membership; First level are often signatories to the FASA, which is a consortium based agreement, these include local health, social service and not for profit agencies, often these agencies form the PCP governance group; second tier of membership includes agencies who are voluntary partners to place based initiatives with the aim of improving the health and wellbeing of the community within the catchment.






DHHS Divisions & Primary Care Partnership Regional Catchments
